

Reviewed border measures to take effect starting in March 2022

Regarding border measures, the following measures will be implemented beginning at 0:00AM on March 1, 2022 (JST).

1. Home quarantine period for persons entering Japan

In principle, a 7-day home quarantine will apply to all entrants. Meanwhile, if the test result on the third day is negative, home quarantine is no longer required for the rest of the period.

A 3-day facility quarantine will apply to entrants from designated countries and regions in response to the Omicron variant.

A quarantine period will be shortened as follows for entrants who have completed their third vaccination shots:

- Entrants arriving from the designated countries/regions: a 3-day home quarantine is required instead of a 3-day facility quarantine.
- Entrants arriving from the non-designated countries/regions: home quarantine is exempted.

The use of public transportation from airport to home for a home quarantine (within 24 hours from the on-arrival test) is allowed.

2. New entry of foreign nationals into Japan

The new entry of foreign nationals into Japan under the supervision of receiving organizations is allowed, except for those entering Japan for tourism.

3. Increase of the daily limit of the total number of entrants into Japan

The daily limit of the total number of entrants into Japan will be increased from about 3,500 to about 5,000 beginning March 1, 2022 (JST).
